
I am requesting funding for the City of Montebello's Acuña Dog Park in Fiscal Year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Montebello, California located at 1600 W. Beverly Blvd., Montebello, CA 90640.

The project is located at Henry Acuña Park, 1700 W. Victoria Ave., Montebello, CA 90640

The funding would be used to construct the Acuña Park Dog Park, the City of Montebello's first dog park, and provide an enclosed area for dogs to exercise, socialize, and play off-leash under the supervision of their own owners. The area that the dog park would be constructed would feature fencing, double-gated entry, benches, dog waste stations, a water station, shade and adequate drainage. The area is approximately 32,630 square feet, located near the center of the park and is adjacent to an existing playground and picnic areas. The City's Park Master Plan identifies Acuña Park as an ideal location for the development of a dog park area due to the available open space and proximity to existing cohesive amenities.
