I am requesting funding for the City of La Palma's Arterial Street Medians Rehabilitation Project in Fiscal Year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of La Palma located at 7822 Walker Street, La Palma, CA 90623.

The project is located at 48 existing and 3 new median islands in the City of La Palma, Orange County, California.

The funding would be used for the removal of existing landscaping/irrigation, hardscape removals and replacement, installation of a new drip irrigation system, planting of new trees along with new landscaping/hardscaping in 48 median islands. Re-grading of the medians is also included to capture irrigation and storm runoff to meet state/federal storm water regulation compliance. Three newly designed median islands on Moody Street from Malaga Avenue to Orangethorpe Avenue would be added, with the completed project presenting a consistent median island design for all of the City roadway medians. This project will be built in preparation for the use of reclaimed water to reduce the use of potable water.
