
I am requesting funding for the Diamond Bar Civic Center Energy Resilience Project. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Diamond Bar located at 21810 Copley Drive Diamond Bar, CA 91765.

Funding for this project will provide installation of a solar photovoltaic shade structure (solar carport) that will generate renewable energy on-site, while providing covered parking for fleet vehicles and charging infrastructure. In addition, a new battery energy storage system would be installed to allow the City to store solar energy produced during the day and use it during peak demand periods or outages. The Project also includes deployment of electric vehicle charging infrastructure for the City's fleet vehicles, as well as municipal fleet charging stations to support the entire City's transition to zero-emission vehicles.

Overall, this Project will create a more resilient and energy-efficient Civic Center campus while supporting the City's compliance with state requirements. It will greatly strengthen the reliability of the Civic Center's energy infrastructure and thereby reduce greenhouse gas emissions, improve regional air quality, lower long-term municipal electricity costs, and help ensure that critical public services remain available to the community during emergencies and extreme weather events. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2) of the United States Code.
