
Dear Chair Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Santa Fe Springs Slauson Avenue Street Improvement Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Santa Fe Springs, CA, located at 11710 E. Telegraph Road, Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670. The funding would be used to improve traffic flow and safety and pedestrian amenities for a 0.77-mile segment of Slauson Avenue, between Sorensen Avenue and Santa Fe Springs Road. The Project consists of removing 2 to 5 inches of existing asphalt concrete and replacing it with fiber reinforced asphalt concrete. New sidewalk construction will include pedestrian amenities, new trees, and an analysis of the feasibility for Class III bike lanes. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the combination of heavy industrial traffic volumes and heavy rainstorms has left the roadway in extremely poor condition. The project site is located within the highest percentile of Disadvantaged Community as defined by the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
