Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Regional Bus Stop Improvement project. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority, located at One Gateway Plaza; Los Angeles, CA 90012.
