Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the Río Hondo College Campus Bike Access Mobility Initiative project. The entity to receive funding for this project is Rio Hondo College located at 3600 Workman Mill Road, Whittier, CA 90601.

This funding would enable the College to install charging stations, including heavy-duty bike racks on campus shuttles, and add storage lockers to safely store E-bikes. This project would improve access to the Rio Hondo College campus for students who cannot afford single-occupancy vehicles and rely on buses and E-bikes to travel to and from campus.
