Any applicant package not postmarked by **Friday, October 19, 2018** will **NOT** be considered. SAT/ACT scores for the October testing dates are the only materials accepted after the deadline. You will receive an acknowledgement, once your application has been processed.

- 3) **Two Teacher Recommendations**: Use the recommendation forms included in the application. Teachers should complete the forms, seal them in envelopes, and return the forms to the student. The forms must arrive with the application package in sealed envelopes. Separate letters of recommendation are **NOT** required.

- 4) **Interview Request Form**

- IV. **Official High School Transcripts**: Transcripts must arrive with the application in a **SEALED** envelope. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.

- V. **Official SAT and/or ACT scores**: The Office of Congresswoman Linda Sánchez has code number **4158** (SAT) and **7277** (ACT).
